<b>Principles:</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• We ensure that teaching and learning opportunities meet the needs of all of the pupils</li> <li>• We ensure that appropriate provision is made for pupils who belong to vulnerable groups, this includes ensuring that the needs of socially disadvantaged pupils are adequately assessed and addressed</li> <li>• In making provision for socially disadvantaged pupils, we recognise that not all pupils who receive free meals will be socially disadvantaged</li> <li>• Disadvantaged funding will be allocated following a needs analysis which will identify priority individuals</li> </ul>	

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>The children's needs are paramount and the funding will swiftly close gaps in learning, in particular with a physical development focus as our children enter the EYFS from such low starting points</li> </ul>
<b>Summary of spending and actions taken:</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Employ a male early years sport and physical development specialist to benchmark children on entry and work in school with families, staff and children to deliver targeted interventions</li> <li>Partly funded from Pupil Premium income</li> </ul>
<b>Outcomes:</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Promote a male role model in early years and improved outcomes for children in relation to physical development particularly in boys supporting physical development and fine motor skills.</li> </ul>
