Our classes have enjoyed holding their assemblies over the last few months—thank you so much to all of the parents/ carers who were able to attend.




Next term, we will be taking a break from our assemblies while we concentrate on other exciting events within school.

# Family Learning



Our latest Family Learning course will be taking place next term, starting on Monday 16th January.

This will be a Stories and Reading course, based on traditional tales. This course will support you as parents/carers to help your EYFS or KSl child with their English, including speaking and listening, and communication and language. The course is run by tutors from Bolton College. The course will run for four weeks until Monday 6th February.



The course timings are 9:00am until 12:00pm. The course is aimed at families of children in Nursery, Reception, Year 1 and Year 2. All adults from our Oxford Grove family are welcome, including parents, carers, grandparents and those will little English.
