Language Ambassadors



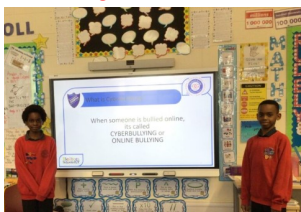
Language Ambassadors work with Miss Khan to support children new to our school who need help with translation and learning English.

By planning your practice time like this, you will keep your times table knowledge sharp and avoid having too much screen time.

Transition and New Classes for 2023-2024

In order to best support our children with their move up to their next class, we will be holding transition after half term. Children will be spending time in their new classes with their new class teachers in order to prepare them for September. We will continue to use flexible grouping for Maths and English in some classes, as we currently do, and children will be able to experience working with their new base class teacher and their flexible grouping teachers.

Every day from Monday 12th June, KS1 and KS2 children will come into school through the main entrance as usual. Reception children moving into Year 1 will continue to come into school through the Foundation Stage as usual. Once in school, children will then move to their new classes.

At the end of the day, children will return to their old class teacher and **leave school through their usual exit**.

Transition will take place full time each week over the term. For the final week of term, children will return to their old class teacher in order to spend time with them before breaking up for the summer holidays.

This year we have two new teachers to Oxford Grove—

Miss Ball (working in Foundation Stage) and Miss Affleck (additional teacher).



The Foundation Stage teaching team will be Mrs Claire, Miss Ridgway and Miss Ball.
